Academic Achievements

The academic year 2024–25 has been a year of remarkable accomplishments for our students and faculty. Our school continues to uphold the CBSE tradition of academic excellence, with an outstanding pass percentage in both Classes X and XII Board Examinations. A total of 188 distinctions in Class X and 15 students securing distinctions in all 5 subjects. A total of 102 distinctions in Class XII and 7 students securing distinctions in all 5 subjects. Regular remedial classes, peer-learning modules, and mentorship programs by faculty contributed significantly to this success.

Efforts in Environment Education

Environmental consciousness remains central to our educational ethos. This year, the school initiated a 'Green Campus Drive', implementing a robust waste segregation system. Students actively participated in plantation drives, anti-plastic campaigns. We proudly conducted Eco Club activities under the CBSE guidelines, where students presented sustainable models and innovative recycling techniques.

Sports Achievements

Physical fitness and sportsmanship are integral to holistic development. This year, our students brought laurels in zonal and state-level competitions. The Annual Sports Day witnessed enthusiastic participation across all grades, with an emphasis on inclusive sports and adapted physical education. Special coaching camps were conducted in collaboration with certified sports trainers in badminton, taekwondo, and yoga.

<u>Innovation and Skill Development</u>

In keeping with the NEP 2020 vision, the school laid special emphasis on fostering innovation and 21st-century skills. Students also participated in CBSE Expression Series, Veer Gatha Project and the Youth Ideathon.

Overall Results

The overall academic performance of the school continues to set benchmarks. With continuous formative assessments, regular parent-student-teacher interactions, and personalized learning plans, the academic graph has shown consistent upward growth.

PTA Activities

The Parent-Teacher Association (PTA) played a proactive role in school development initiatives. Monthly PTA meetings ensured two-way feedback on academic progress, school safety, and student well-being. Workshops on digital parenting, adolescent mental health, and career counseling were organized.
